
## Which Middle Eastern Country Provided Homes and Citizenship to 600,000 Refugees Expelled from Arab Countries



## Only Israel

Many Israelis know firsthand what it is like to be forced from homes and native lands without compensation. Arab countries expelled nearly 1 million indigenous Jews over a 20-year period starting in the 1940s. Despite its small size, Israel alone managed to reach out and provide humanitarian relief and citizenship to more than 600,000 of those refugees.
